Please follow all steps so that we may process your application:

1. ENCLOSE PROOF OF BREED by choosing only one of three options:

- JOCKEY CLUB (JC) PAPERS: Please enclose a copy with Registration Application.
- OR, IF JC PAPERS ARE NOT AVAILABLE, ENCLOSE JOCKEY CLUB TATTOO RESEARCH FORM 611: To order, call the Jockey Club and request Tattoo Research, Form Number 611

- OR, IF YOU OWN NO JC PAPERS AND HAVE ONLY PARTIALLY LEGIBLE TATTOO: If your only Proof of Breed is a partially legible tattoo (no clear tattoo to obtain the JC Tattoo Research Form 611), please refer to page six, Instructions for Hard-To-Read Tattoo.

2. PHOTO ID IS REQUIRED: Previous members, see next paragraph. New members, see pages three through five. Five color photographs (size 4x6, glossy or non-glossy) are required: one of each full body side view, one of full body front, one of full body back. Also one close head shot from the front, to show all on the entire face (move forelock aside). Photos need not be professional quality, but be sure all markings are clearly visible, and the total leg is shown, including the complete hoof.

PREVIOUS MEMBERS PHOTO ID: Check off the ballot boxes on pages three through five, indicating photos are already on file.

3. IF REQUIRED IN YOUR STATE/PROVINCE, ENCLOSE A COPY OF YOUR CURRENT COGGINS OR PASSPORT: Ask vet to fill out all areas on the Coggins including markings, physical characteristics, and tattoo area. If tattoo is only partially legible, indicate unreadable spaces with question marks. Make sure all vet's contact information is filled out completely.

4. ENCLOSE APPLICATION AND FEE: Be sure to fill out all applicable sections, and include membership fee payable to North American Thoroughbred Society, along with application.

Realizing that: (1) Jockey Club papers are often withheld on purpose at the track so the horse isn't returned to the track; (2) it is NATBS policy that competitors who acquire their thoroughbred without papers should not be penalized; (3) the full process of a vet check, a NATBS Veterinarian Affidavit, NATBS Gelding History Form, and NATBS review of each individual case, may constitute the applicant's full acceptance into NATBS.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR HARD-TO-READ TATTOO

The Jockey Club suggests using a black light. If the character in question becomes readable, apply for the Five Generation Pedigree, Jockey Club Tattoo Research Form 611. Please follow these steps:

(1) Have your vet use a black light. Stand horse in an area with no direct light, flip lip up, shine light on inside upper lip. (2) If you don't own a black light, ask your vet before hand to bring one (vets have black lights as standard equipment). (3) have vet write tattoo number in appropriate box on current Coggins. If character is still not completely legible, fill space with a question mark: M4?700.

IMPORTANT: If vet has written in any question marks, indicating tattoo is not completely legible, your horse must be of non-breeding stock (gelding only) to be considered for NATBS membership. Fill out the gelding's history below as you know it. Have vet fill out Vet Tattoo Affidavit For Geldings on this page and submit all to our registry along with the current Coggins. We deeply regret that we do not accept breeding stock (mares, stallions) without Jockey Club approved pedigree.

I, the veterinarian, have reviewed this entire page and have (1) used a black light as recommended above, (2) determined to the best of my knowledge that this gelding is bearing an authentic Jockey Club tattoo that is not completely legible. The characteristics of this particular tattoo do not in any way appear peculiar, it does appear to have faded appropriately given the age and condition of the horse.
